Self-Defense Training Inauguration for Girl Students on 12-12-2019.

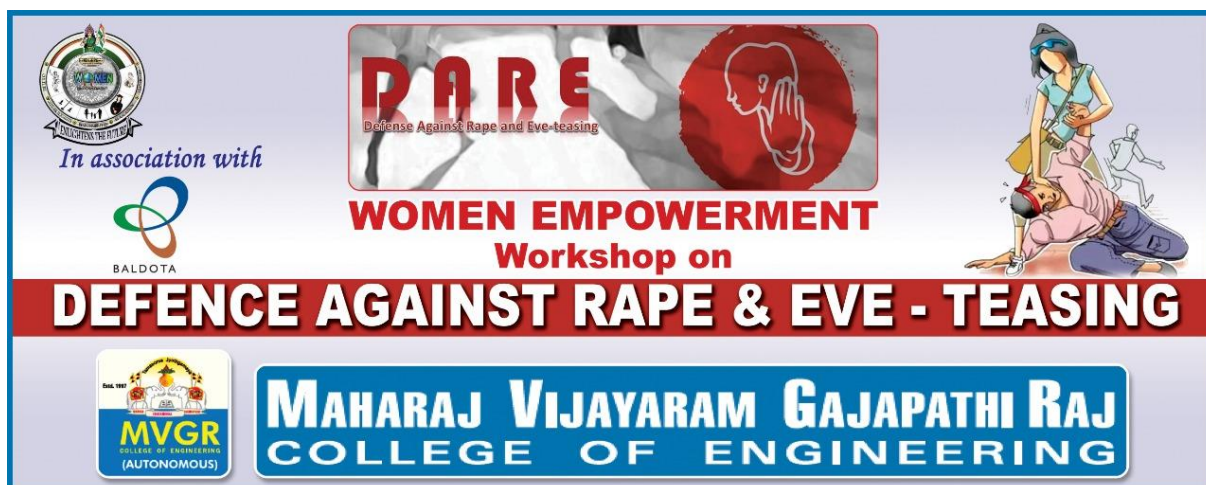

She explained that women need financial independence so that they can be mentally fit. She also emphasized that the difference between good touch and bad touch should be taught to girl students from an early age.

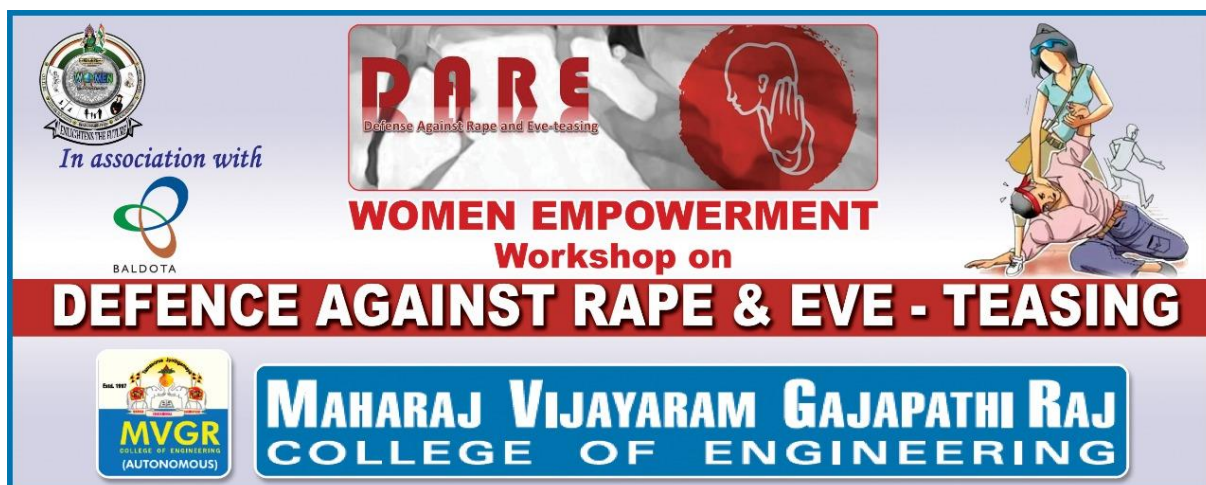

Finally the chief guest were emphasized the special job opportunities for the students who are there in NCC roles. For this event students participated with great motivation and involvement.

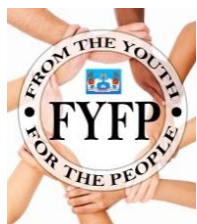
“Swatch Bharath Summer Internship” on 24-09-2019.

All the activities are doing after the academic hours and in holidays. FYFP is running all the activities with support from the college Principal Dr. KVL Raju, Vice Principal Dr. YMC Sekhar, Dean (Student Affairs) Dr. S.SrinivasRao.

All the activities coordinated by Dr.M.SatyaNarayana, Professor, Dept of ECE.

Vision:

To create awareness among the students about the society.

- To provide annual writing aid for the poor children.
- To support primary education for children.
- To create awareness about women health care.
- To bring change in the society and sensitize against evil things in the society.

PROJECT KITAB

Project Kitab is unique idea from the students of FYFP started in the year 2012 to provide annual study aid to poor children of various Govt. schools. In this project waste paper is collected from students, labs, hostels and staff rooms and segregated according to quality of paper and later the segregated paper is traded for wealth.

PROJECT KITAB SEASON-1

Initially for season -1 FYFP team collected an weight of 1.6 tonnes of paper and could generate an amount of Rs.12,625/-. With the generated amount around 108 children were given annual study aid.

PROJECT KITAB SEASON-2

3.33 tonnes of paper was collected and provided study aid to 195 children in chittigunkalam, venkannapeta, godayyapalem and betheren orphanage.

PROJECT KITAB SEASON-3

4.8 tonnes of paper was collected. All the work was well appreciated by Principal sir and college administration.



Chulah Distribution:

A campaign which was conducted in nearby village named “pedada” which comes under raghumanda mandal. It was a one day campaign which is based on distribution of chulas in co-ordination of NED-CAP.

In the process of making a model village we are trying to promote the village to use non conventional energy resources as a part of it during one day campaign conducted at pedada village on 31st may it was promised by FYFP that the people in the village would be getting the smokeless chulas very soon. keeping this in view FYFP has co-ordinated with the “ned-cap” and had seen to that the people in the pedada village would get the chulas.

Cloth Collection & Utensil Distribution

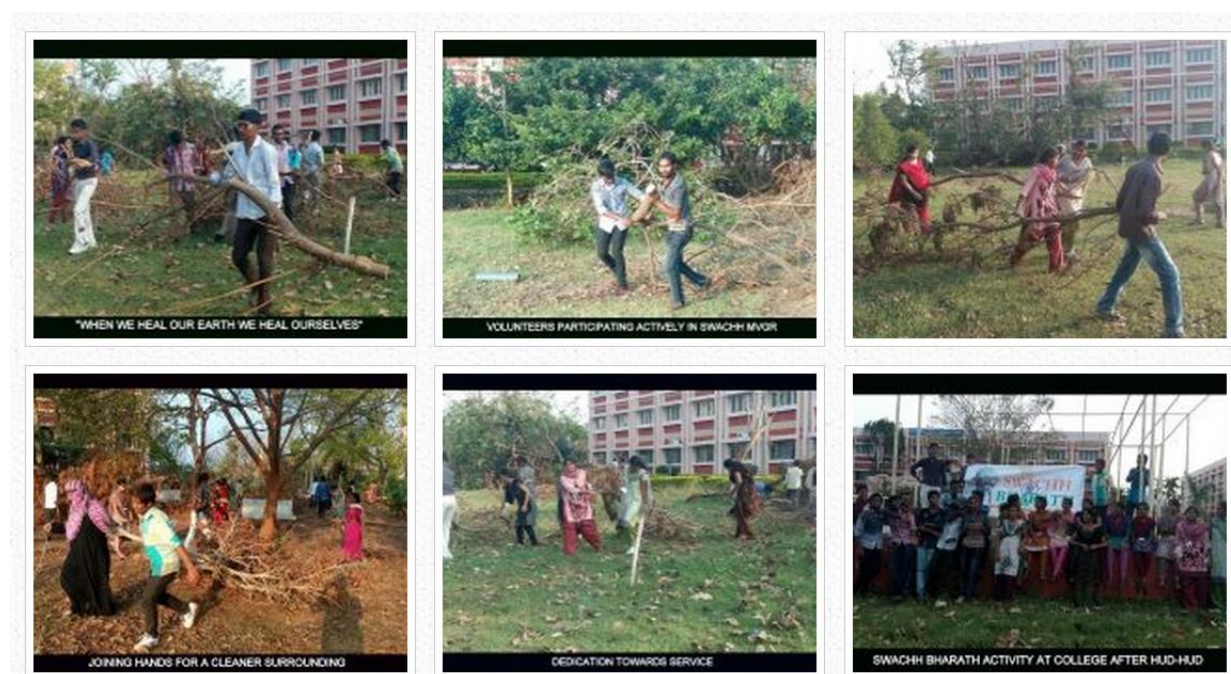

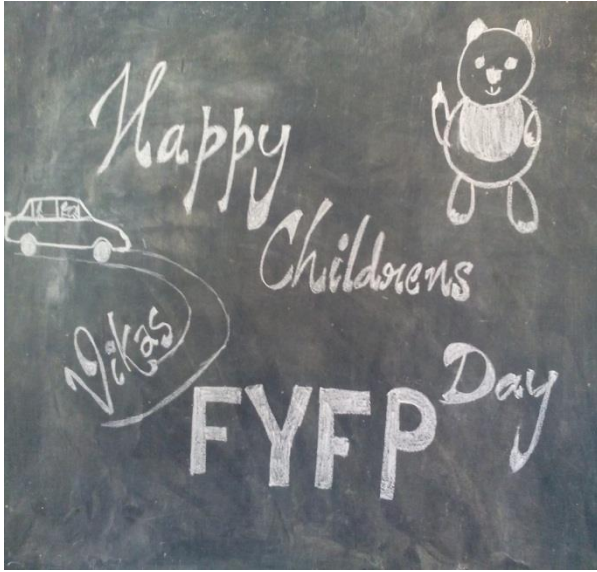

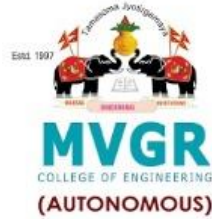
